
VIOLATION HEARING MINUTES – March 4, 2026

The Allegany County Board of License Commissioners held their violation hearings on Wednesday, March 4, 2026. The hearings were conducted at 10 A.M. in Room 100 of the Allegany County Office Complex. Present for the meeting were Chairman – Tom Farrell, Commissioner – Jim Stafford, Office Administrator – Brandy Snyder, Chief Inspector – Keith Bageant, and Board Attorney - Ramani Pillai. Also in attendance were Amit Shah, Tammy Haggerty, and Mel Tobiczky.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Farrell.

Alcoholic Beverage Compliance checks are performed by the Allegany County Sheriff's Department. These compliance checks are performed to ensure that businesses are complying with the laws regarding the sale of alcoholic beverages to an individual under the age of 21. A confidential source under the age of 21 assists with the compliance checks.

Danny's One Stop, 15808 McMullen Hwy SW, Cumberland – On December 31, 2025 Employee, Sansay Suthar sold a 25-oz can of Michelob Ultra, an alcoholic beverage, for \$3.26 to a minor. Licensee, Amit Shah plead guilty to the charge. Mr. Shah also stated that said employee has been terminated. Chairman stated that burden of proof had been met.

PENALTY: \$500 fine with \$250 being suspended and probation for one year. If another underage sale occurs within the year, then the \$250 will be reinstated with the new fine. Motioned by Chairman Farrell and unanimously approved by Commissioner Stafford

Best Price Fuel, 21413 Chesapeake Avenue SW, McCoole – On December 31, 2025 employee, Matt Eichelberger, sold a 25-oz can of Michelob Ultra, an alcoholic beverage, for \$3.26 to an individual under the age of 21. Licensee, Tammy Haggerty plead guilty to the charge. Ms. Haggerty stated that the employee has been terminated. Chairman Farrell stated that the burden of proof had been met.

PENALTY: \$500 fine with \$250 being suspended and probation for one year. If another underage sale occurs within the year, then \$250 will be reinstated with new fine. Motioned by Chairman Farrell and unanimously approved by Commissioner Stafford.



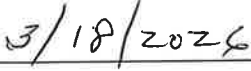
